







REMOVE HEADREST (IF APPLICABLE)



A. Tab(s) at headrest base. Depress tab(s) and lift the headrest out.



B. Pin holes on headrest Insert a paper-clip end into the hole.



C. Some may have both.

NOTE: In some cases where the headrest is not removable there is an allowance in the seat cover to fit over the headrest.

BACKREST COVER

SEAT WITH THE BACK FLAPS ATTACHED

NOTE 1

IN SOME APPLICATIONS, THE BACK FLAP ON THE SEAT CAN BE RELEASED **EITHER BY UNHOOKING THE ELASTIC** LOOP OR BY REMOVING THE PLASTIC **CLIP UNDERNEATH THE SEAT.**

IN THIS INSTALLATION THE BACK FLAP ATTACHED TO THE SEAT CANNOT BE REMOVED.



Step 1. Slip the cover over the backrest, ensuring the side airbag opening is on the door side.


For seats with built in seat belts, open zipper. Slip cover over backrest ensuring cover is installed under seat belt strap.



Step 4. Slip on headrest cover.



Step 2. Tuck carpet strips through the crevice and attach to Velcro at back.




Step 5. Replace headrests. If there are no pre-cut holes, cut a small hole in the stretchy fabric just big enough to accommodate each post.

Step 3. With seat in most upright position, pass back straps through crevice. Then feed straps under seat and buckle to front of cushion cover when installed.




Step 1. Release seat belt buckle from elastic holder (if applicable).




Step 2. Place cover on seat cushion ensuring that the washing label is to the inside and the long side strap is on the door side.



Step 3. With seat in most upright position, pass the straps sewn on the back of the cushion cover through the crevice. Feed straps under the seat and buckle to front of cushion cover.



SOME CUSHION COVER STRAPS FEED FROM THE FRONT, UNDER THE SEAT AND BUCKLE AT THE BACK.




CUSHION COVER

Step 4. Pass long side strap through the opening between the molded plastic and the seat. Buckle to opposite side.



Step 5. Adjust cover for better fit.



Step 6. Adjust Velcro and straps to equalize tension.
