## **Use & Care Instructions**

Thank you for your purchase of our Carhartt® Cargo Area Liner.

The Custom-Patterned units are constructed of a very durable and breathable Carhartt<sup>®</sup> Duck Weave polycotton fabric.



## Installing the Cargo Area Liner is easy.

- First attach the strap and clip around the headrest or the headrest post and adjust the tightness by pulling on the loose end of the strap. Side release buckles are included with the straps for easy removal.
- Spread the liner over the area from side to side and front to back and then move to the rear of the vehicle. Secure the tie straps to the available anchor points of the vehicle. The pattern may not use all the anchor points, but be sure to tie the webbing to the selected locations.
- Be sure to fold the bumper flap UNDER the cargo liner when not in use. When you are using the cargo liner raise the bumper flap UP after you load the vehicle. The bumper flap will help protect the inside of the tailgate.

## CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Cargo Area Liner is simple to maintain and a quick shake will normally be enough to remove surface dirt.

You can also wash your Cargo Area Liner in a conventional washing machine, using cold water, a low-sudsing detergent and a gentle cycle setting. DO NOT use bleach or fabric softener.

Dry covers using the "air" or "low heat" setting on a standard tumble dryer. They may also be line dried, weather conditions and temperature permmitting. DO NOT IRON.
