

JEEP CHEROKEE REAR MUD GUARD INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


Please read instructions thoroughly before installation.

Tools Required

- 1/8" drill bit
- Drill
- Short Phillips screwdriver or drill attachment

Package Contents

- Driver & passenger side mud guard
- #10 SEM screw (qty. 8)
- U-clip (qty. 8)
- Instruction sheet
- **NOTE:** It may be necessary to remove the wheels depending on the tools being used for installation.
- 1. Clean and degrease the mud guard location area on the fender before installation.
- 2. Position mud guard to fender ensuring that it is flush with fender and parallel to the ground.
- 3. Using the mud guard as the template drill holes through the plastic fender liner in positions A, B, C and D.
- 4. Starting at hole location A, install SEM screw through the mud guard hole and the new fender liner hole into a U-clip on the back side of the liner. The U-clip will be used as a nut. (See Figure 2).
- 5. Repeat step 4 for hole locations B, C and D.
- 6. Ensure the mud guard is parallel to the ground before tightening
