

### **PROCEDURE**

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

2. Proceed to the passenger side rocker panel and locate the black rubber plugs and remove them see **Figure 1**. For bracket C (Item 4) mount location, install M8 nut clip (Item 5) as shown in **Figure 2**. Proceed to install the remaining M8 nut clips as shown in **Figure 3**.



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
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
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

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








3. Take the mounting brackets and install the bracket and associated hardware loosely to it's corresponding positions see **Figures 4, 5, and 6**. Brackets used for the passenger side are (1) bracket C (Item 4), (1) bracket D (Item 5) and (2) bracket B (Item 3). The driver side will use the remaining (2) bracket B and (2) bracket A (Item 2). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time. **Note:** On 1500 crew cab models, front positions will have a welded nut on pinch weld and must refer to **Figure 7** for bracket installation.

For 2015-2016 diesel equipped models: The D.E.F tank must be removed prior to installing the front brackets on the passenger side. For D.E.F tank removal instructions, please refer to page 5. Note: Bracket location is critical.












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


- 4. Carefully install (2) M6 bolt plates (included with step bars) into the bottom of the step bar as shown see **Figure 8**. Place step bar onto bracket saddle and align the bolt plate to the saddle slot holes as shown see **Figure 9**. Once fully aligned, assemble with M6 fasteners see **Figure 9**.
- 5. Make sure the mounting brackets and step bar are aligned then proceed to fully tighten all hardware. Recommended torque values are 18 FT.LBS. for M8 hex head bolts and 8 FT.LBS. for M6 fasteners.
- 6. Proceed to reinstall D.E.F tank on 2011-16 diesel models.





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
## Care Instructions


- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.



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# DEF TANK REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR 11-16 DIESEL MODELS ONLY







**Step 4.** Using a ratchet with a long extension and a 13mm socket loosen and remove the bolts of the tank support straps. (depending on model, bolts may be 13mm head socket or Torx T-40 bit.)



**Step 6.** Carefully bring the tank down trying not to tilt or twist the tank to avoid damage to connectors.

Note: Trimming might be required on the plastic cover, at the bracket location.
