
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PROCEDURE


- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- Start installation on driver's side. On the rocker panel find locations of factory studs. In each location there should be 3 studs. See Figure 1.
- Insert (1) M8 Plastic Retainer (Item 12) on each factory stud. See Figure 2.







- Insert the M8 round head square neck bolt (Item 11) through the Universal Mounting Bracket's (Item 7) square hole. Then insert the M8 round head square neck bolt through mounting brackets (Item 2 - 6) bottom circular hole. Loosely secure with (1) M8 hex nut, (1) M8 split lock washer, and (1) M8 flat washer. See Figure 3.
- 5. Align sub-assembly with the 3 factory studs. Lower 2 factory studs will align with the Universal Mounting Bracket and top factory stud will align with mounting brackets. Loosely secure sub-assembly with (3) M8 hex nut, (3) M8 split lock washer, and (3) M8 flat washer. See Figure 4.
- Repeat Step 3-4 for front, center, and rear mounting locations on both passenger and driver side.

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
- 7. Locate the two mounting locations at the rear of the cab of truck. There will be holes to insert the supplied nut clips (item 15). Locate Mounting Bracket A (Item 23) and install loosely with supplied M8 hardware. See **Figure 5**
- 8. Locate Top Isolator mounting area underneath the bed at the front of the rear wheel well. There will be a portion of the bed with 2 large holes where (item 25) will be mounted. Locate Top Isolator Bracket (Item 5) and loosely install with the supplied M10 bolt plate and hardware. See **Figure 6 & 7**






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
- 9. Install Bottom Isolator Bracket (Item 21) to previously mounted Top Isolator Bracket (Item 5) with the supplied Isolator Kit (Item 26) and M12 Hardware. Assemble loosely. **See Figure 8**
- 10. Tilt Board at angle to insert brackets into mounting locations for (Item 23). See Figure 9







(NOTE: Reference for bracket locations and orientations can be found in Figure 12 on pg. 5)

- 11. For Step Board installation to the previously installed mounting brackets use the supplied M8 hardware with short bolts on Mounting Bracket A (Item 23) and use M8 hardware with long bolts for all other mounting location. See **Figure 10 and 11.**
- 12. Align step bar and brackets to desired positioning then torque and tighten all: M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs, M10 to 32-38 ft -lbs, and M12 to 52-60 ft-lbs.
