
PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Begin by removing the plastic caps on the bed rails and then using a torx bit to remove the rails. See Figure 1.
- 3. Obtain the Mounting Bracket and position it to the bed as shown in Figure 2.






- 4. After replacing the bed rail to its original position, secure the Mounting Bracket to the vehicle with the supplied M6 Hardware in the factory mounting locations. See Figure 3. Note: Long bed models will use the inner-most hole on the Mounting Bracket. Short bed models will use the outer-most hole. See Figure 4.
- 5. The hardware mounting through the hole in the Mounting Bracket can be secured using a socket extension. See Figure 5.








- 6. Note the hardware configuration for **Steps 4-5.** See **Figure 6.**
- 7. Repeat **Steps 2-6** for the opposite side of the vehicle.
- 8. Position the Hoop/Screen Assembly as shown in **Figure 7.**



- 9. Using the supplied M8 Hardware secure the Hoop/Screen Assembly to the Mounting Brackets as shown in Figure 8.
- 10. Torque all hardware; M6 to 8-11ft-lb, M8 to 15-18 ft-lb.



Note: When tightening M8 hardware that was used to install hoop and screen assembly on step 8, push the top of the HLR rack towards the cab of the truck to maintain straight while tightening.
