




Driver's Side Shown, Passenger Side Opposite


ITEM 1

PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Obtain the Skid Plate Mounting Brackets (2) along with the supplied M8 Hardware (3-12).
- 3. Secure the Skid Plate Mounting Brackets (2) to the Skid Plate Assembly (1) as shown in Figure 1.




4. Loosely install skid (1) plate with the supplied M8 flange bolts (3) and M8 serrated flange nuts (4) according to **Figures 2** & 3. *Note*: For Rubicon models with auto sway bar disconnect, a wobble socket is recommended to tighten the inner two bolts



- 5. For models with OEM steel bumpers, there will be M10 Hardware with rivcerts already in place. See Figure 4.
- 6. In this case, use the OEM bolts to secure the Skid Plate Mounting Bracket to the vehicle. See Figure 5.
- 7. For models with OEM plastic bumpers, the supplied M8 Hex Rivcerts (12) will be used along with the supplied shirt M8 Hex Bolts (5), Flat Washer (7), and Lock Washer (9). **See Figure 6** for Rivcert Installation.










CLOSE OUT PANEL & RIVCERT INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- Before installing the close out panel (14), widen the hole in the frame indicated in **Figure 7** to 7/16" with a drill. Repeat procedure on the passenger's side. *Note*: Driver's side is shown.
- 9. Slip an M8 flat washer (8) over the long M8 hex head cap screw (10) and then insert the cap screw into the M8 universal rivcert tool (13). Loosely thread the long M8 hex head cap screw into an M8 splined rivcert (11). See Figure 8.
- 10. Insert the M8 rivcert (11) into the driver's side hole widened in step 6 and tighten the M8 hex head cap screw while simultaneously applying pressure with the rivcert tool until there is significant resistance. *Note*: When the rivcert is installed, it will have collapsed and fastened itself to the hole. See Figure 9.
- 11. Remove the hex head cap screw, washer, and rivcert tool. Repeat steps 6-8 on the passenger's side of the vehicle.








12. Install the close out panel (14) using the supplied M8 button head hardware according to Figure 10.
