



IMPORTANT:

The manufacturer is not responsible for negligent use of vehicle with mud flaps installed, including over-tightening of screws and bolts causing damage to vehicle or mud flaps.



Note: Drill with caution, do not drill through the wheel well or wheel flare.

- 7. Cut protective plastic and peel away from the stainless steel.
- 8. Secure the flap with four flat washers and four tek screws on hole 'A' to 'D'.
- 9. Repeat procedure for the passenger side. Mud Flaps are now ready to install onto a vehicle.



DRILL FOUR Ø3/16" HOLES FROM THE STAINLESS PANEL THROUGH THE RUBBER FLAP

MAKE SURE THE CUT-OFF EDGE OF THE FLAP IS FLUSH AGAINST TO THE BOTTOM OF THE OFFSET PANEL AND CENTERED, BEFORE DRILLING
