
TOOLS REQUIRED:


a) (1) Upper Mount Rear, DS Part #766387





b) (1)Upper Mount Rear, PS Part #766388

i) (1) Mount Clip PS, Clinch Nut





INSTALLATION:

- 1. Before you install your mud flap set, see the diagram, templates, and parts list for all necessary parts.
- 2. Place template onto mud flap, ensuring that holes #1 & #2 are aligned with the dimples on the rubber (as shown on diagram on template). Cut the slotted holes into the rubber.
- 3. Install upper mount on mud flap, ensuring that the lower dimples on the rubber are utilized as shown in Diagram #1. Secure using (3) machine screws #012034, (3) flat washers #018018, and (3) nylock nuts #025005.
- 4. Remove the (3) factory screws on holes #5 to #7 as shown in Diagram #2.
- 5. Install the mud flap clip to the hole #1 with a capscrew #014066 and a flat washer #018028, then tighten screw until the bottom tab of the mud flap clip just passes through the bottom slotted hole of hole #1.
- 6. Install factory screws through holes #2 to #4 into factory holes #5 to #7 as shown in Diagram #2. Ensure that the installed mud flap clip is behind the factory wheel fender lip.
- 7. Square the flap with the tire while putting pressure against the wheel well and tighten the factory screw on holes #2 to #4.
- 8. Secure the upper tab of the mud flap by sliding the installed mud flap clip on hole #1 to the wheel well until mud flap clip's teeth are gripped behind the wheel fender lip, then tighten the screw.
- 9. Repeat procedure for the passenger side.
















DRIVER SIDE

- 1. LAY TEMPLATE ONTO THE FRONT OF THE MUD FLAP MAKE SURE TO ALIGN HOLE #1 & #2 WITH BOTTOM ROW DIMPLES ON THE MUD FLAP AS SHOWN
- 2. DRILL & CUT 4 SLOTTED HOLES





PASSENGER SIDE

- 1. LAY TEMPLATE ONTO THE FRONT OF THE MUD FLAP MAKE SURE TO ALIGN HOLE #1 & #2 WITH BOTTOM ROW DIMPLES ON THE MUD FLAP AS SHOWN
- 2. DRILL & CUT 4 SLOTTED HOLES
