Periodic inspection of your product should be performed to ensure all hardware and / or components remain secure.

Be sure to inspect and test fit product before having it coated or painted. Ranch Hand will not be responsible for the cost of the coating if any problems with fit or finish are not noted and addressed beforehand.

Remove the large tow hook from the vehicle.

To help prevent damage to the product or vehicle, refer to the specified torque specifications when securing hardware during the installation process.

Maintenance

Mild automotive detergent may be used to clean the product. Do not use dish detergent, abrasive cleaners, abrasive pads, wire brushes or other similar products that may damage the finish.

Step 1

Remove the tow hooks if equipped onto the vehicle.






Step 2

Mount the top mounting brackets to the front side of the bumper bracket.

Loosen the bolt near the rear side with a 10mm socket or a 14mm E-Type socket.

The bottom side of the top bracket will mount the inside of the bottom mounting bracket. Use two (2) carriage bolts, washers, and nuts to install.

Do not tighten at this time.







Step 3

Loosely install the bottom mounting brackets to the location of the tow hooks.

Reuse the tow hook bolts. Reinstall the small tow hook but not the large tow hook.

Mount the top brackets to the bottom brackets by using the 1/2" black carriage bolts, washers and nuts.





Step 4

Install the grill guard to the bottom brackets with two (2) 1/2" black carriage bolts, washers, and nuts for each side.

Step 5

Level the grill guard and tighten all hardware.

Step 6

For vehicles without a camera, install the small insert by using the 1/4" x 3/4" black button head bolts and nuts.
