



INSTALLATION:

- 1. Before you install your mud flap set, see the diagram, templates, and parts list for all necessary parts. Cut protective plastic and peel away from stainless steel. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Install upper mount on mud flap, ensuring that the lower dimples on the rubber are utilized as shown in Diagram #1. Secure using (3) machine screws #012025, (3) flat washers #018018, and (3) nylock nuts #025005.
- 3. Install the mud flap clip to hole #1 with a capscrew #014007 and a flat washer #018028. Tighten screw until the bottom tab of the mud flap clip just passes through the bottom slotted hole of hole #1 as shown in Diagram #2.
- 4. Remove the factory screw on the wheel tub as shown on the diagram and reinstall factory screw on hole #3 through the factory hole #4 as Shown in Diagram #2. Loosely secure at this point. Ensure the installed mud flap clip is behind the factory wheel well.
- 5. Square the flap with the tire while putting pressure against the wheel well and tighten the factory screw on hole #3 as shown in Diagram #2.
- 6. Now secure the flap with a flat washer #018028 and a self-tapping tek screw #010011 on hole #2 through the wheel tub as shown in Diagram #2.
- 7. Secure the upper tab of the mud flap by sliding the installed mud flap clip on hole #1 to the wheel well until mud flap clips teeth are griping behind the wheel well, then tighten the screw.
- 8. Check all fasteners for tightness. Repeat procedure for passenger side.
