


IMPORTANT:


Manufacturer is not responsible for negligent use of vehicle with mud flaps installed, including over-tightening of screws and bolts causing damage to vehicle or mud flaps.



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INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on the driver's side.
- 2. Remove the three factory screws from the inner fender well, and one factory screw from the bottom side of the fender in order to remove the factory guard.
- 3. Reinstall the factory screw in the bottom of the fender.
- 4. Install hole #1 on "L" bracket on mud flap hole #2 using a cap screw (014073) and flat washer (018069), and secure with a flat washer (018069), lock washer (024000), and hex nut (025000).
- 5. Install mud flap holes #3 to #5 to the factory fender holes using a screw (010027) and washer (018072). Loosely secure at this time.
- 6. Using a bubble level or square, ensure that the flap is square.
- 7. Tighten all fasteners.
- 8. Clamp the "L" bracket to the factory liner as shown in the installation video, and drill a ¹/₄" hole through each of the holes in the bracket into the factory liner.
- 9. Install the bracket through hole #6 to the liner using a machine screw (012022) and washer (018018), and secure using a washer (018018), lock washer (024001) and hex nut (025003). Remove vice grips and repeat the procedure for hole #7.
- 10. Repeat procedure for the passenger side.





IMPORTANT:

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INSTALLATION (For ease of installation it is suggested that the wheel be removed)

- 1. Before you install your Mud Flap Set, see the diagram and parts list for all necessary parts. Start on driver's side.
- 2. Remove the factory screws and push pin from the inner wheel well, and the underside of the fender.
- 3. Remove the factory guard.
- 3. Reinstall the factory screw on the underside of the fender.



- 4. Install the bracket hole #1 through mud flap hole #2 using a capscrew (014073) and flat washer (018069), and secure using a flat washer (018069), lock washer (024000), and hex nut (025000).
- 5. Install the bracket through hole #3 to the inner most factory hole using a capscrew (014073) and flat washer (018069) and secure using a flat washer (018069), lock washer (024000), and hex nut (025000).
- 6. Secure mud flap holes #4 to #6 to factory fender holes using a sheet metal screw (010027) and flat washer (018070).
- 7. Using a bubble level or square, ensure that the flap is square.
- 8. Secure all fasteners.
- 9. Repeat procedure for the passenger's side.
